## **Cutting Instructions:**

Fabric A: Words – Blue

• Cut two 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric B: Horseshoes & Badges - Red

- Cut two 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirteen 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares.
- Cut five 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-eight 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### Fabric C: Paisley – Brown

- Cut four 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares.
- Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.



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## **Cutting Instructions - Continued:**

Fabric D: Paisley – Red

- Cut four 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares.
- Cut four 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut four 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric E: Paisley – Blue

- Cut two 4  $\frac{7}{6}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirteen 4  $\frac{7}{6}$ " squares.
- Cut four 5 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 5 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make ninety-six triangles.
- Cut two 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fourteen 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric F: Words – Red

 $\bullet$  Cut two 8  $1\!\!\!/ 2''$  x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 8  $1\!\!/ 2''$  squares.

Fabric G: Cowboy Pictures – Blue

- Cut two 5 1/2" x 76 1/2" LOF strips.
- Cut two 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

Fabric H: Palette Basics – Cream

- Cut four 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-six 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares.
- Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.
- Cut six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ninety-six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut seven 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fourteen 4 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips.

Fabric I: Boards – Brown

• Cut eight 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric J: Horseshoes & Badges – Blue

- Cut three 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut one 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Backing: Paisley – Tan


• Cut two 94" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 78" x 94" for the back.



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### **Block Assembly:**


 Place one 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric H square on top of one 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two blocks. Trim blocks to measure 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square to make two Unit 1's (Fig. 3). Repeat to make twenty-six Unit 1's total.



- 2. Repeat Step 1 using thirteen 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric E squares and thirteen 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric H squares to make twenty-six 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Unit 2's (Fig. 4).
- 3. Repeat Step 1 using forty-eight 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric D squares and forty-eight 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" Fabric C squares to make ninety-six 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Unit 3's (Fig. 5).
- 4. Sew two Fabric E triangles, one Fabric H triangle and one Fabric C triangle together to make one Unit 4 (Fig. 6). Repeat to make forty-eight Unit 4's total.




5. Place one 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" away from the sewn seam.




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- 6. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a 4 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 ½" Fabric A square to make one Unit 5 (Fig. 10).
- 7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make six Unit 5's total.
- 8. Repeat Steps 5-6 using six 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric F squares and twenty-four 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric J squares to make six Unit 6's (Fig. 11).



- 9. Follow Figure 12 and sew two Unit 1's, two Unit 2's, eight Unit 3's, four Unit 4's, one Unit 5 and eight 2 1/2" Fabric H squares together to make one Block One. Repeat to make six Block Ones total.
- 10. Follow Figure 13 and sew two Unit 1's, two Unit 2's, eight Unit 3's, four Unit 4's, one Unit 6 and eight 2 ½" Fabric H squares together to make one Block Two. Repeat to make six Block Twos total.



11. Place one 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric B square on the left side of one 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 16 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowance.




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12. Place one 4 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 16). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 16). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 17). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make one Unit 7.

13. Repeat Steps 11-12 to make six Unit 7's total.

14. Repeat Steps 11-12 and use Figure 18 for fabric identification and location to make eight Unit 8's.



## Quilt Assembly – Refer to the Quilt Layouts while assembling the quilt top:

- 15. Sew one Block One to each side of one Block Two to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 16. Sew one Block Two to each side of one Block One to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 17. Sew the four rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.
- 18. Sew four Unit 8's together end to end to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the Units.
- 19. Sew three Unit 7's together end to end. Sew one Unit 1 to the left end of the strip. Sew one Unit 2 to the right end of the strip. Sew the resulting strip to the top of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the Units.
- 20. Sew three Unit 7's together end to end. Sew one Unit 2 to the left end of the strip and one Unit 1 to the right end of the strip. Sew the resulting strip to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the Units.
- 21. Sew one 2 ½" x 72 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 22. Sew one 5 ½" x 76 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 5 ½" Fabric J square to each end of one 5 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.




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23. Layer and quilt as desired.

24. Sew the eight 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.

25. Bind as desired.



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
