



### MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 1 1/2 yards 35362A-7
- 2 yards 35370A-2
- 7/8 yard 35508-3
- 1 yard 35509-2
- 7/8 yard 35509-1
- 7/8 yard 35509-5
- •1/3 yard each 35502-X, 35503-X, 35504-4, 35506-5
- 1/4 yard each 35505-X, 35504-2, 35504-1, 35507-4, 35507-5, 35506-1, 35504-3

#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Read all instructions first!

Label pieces with tape marked with the pattern name and size as you cut them out. This will make them easier to find later.

We'll trim off selvedges from all WOF (width-of-fabric) strips in Step 6, before quilting.

Press each seam after sewing.

### STEP 1: CUT OUT THE FABRIC

35362A-7

Cut (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips

Cut (8) 2" x WOF strips

Cut (8) 4" x WOF strips

35370A-2

Cut (16) 1 1/2" x WOF strips

Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips

Cut (8) 2 1/4" x WOF strips, Subcut into (144) 2 1/4" squares

Cut (6) 3" x WOF strips, Subcut into (18) 11" strips

35508-3

Cut (12) 2 1/2" x WOF strips

35509-2

Cut (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips

Cut (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips, Subcut into (72) 2 1/2" squares

Cut (6) 3" x WOF strips, Subcut into (18) 11" strips

35509-1

Cut (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips

Cut (8) 3" x WOF strips, Subcut into (24)11" strips

33509-5

Cut (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips, Subcut into (72) 2 1/4" squares

Cut (6) 3" x WOF strips, Subcut into (18) 11" strips

35502-X

Cut (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips

35505-X, 35504-1, 35507-4, 35507-5, 35504-2, 35506-1, 35504-3

Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips, Subcut into (6) 11" strips


35503-X, 35504-4, 35506-5

Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips, Subcut into (12) 11" strips

This quilt is made up of 3 types of main panels with white borders in between.



### STEP 2: MAKE PANEL A

Using 2 of the 35370A-2 1 1/2" x WOF strips, sew short ends together, making a 1 1/2" x 86" strip. Repeat with 2 more strips to make one additional 86" long strip. You should have 2 total.


Using 2 of the 35508-3 2 1/2" x WOF strips, sew short ends together, making a 86" long strip. Repeat with 2 more strips to make one additional 86" long strip. You should have 2 total.


To make the center chevron we'll make two strips then piece together.

Using your 11" subcut strips, refer to the diagram for piecing order, and piece together so each end is offset slightly from the previous one.




As you go, make sure it's straight by lining it up on your cutting mat at a 45 degree angle to check that it's slightly wider than 5 1/2".

Piece in sections of 5-6 at a time, then stitch them all together. You should have 26 total strips when complete.



To make the other half of the chevron offset each end slightly in the opposite direction. Double check that you're piecing them in the exact same order!

Once you've completed both rows, place rows at a 45 degree angle and trim to 5 1/2" wide. Stitch together, matching up patterns and seams to complete your chevron.



Piece Panel A in the following order:

1 1/2" 35370A-7 strip 2 1/2" 35508-3 strip Chevron Strip 2 1/2" 35508-3 strip 1 1/2" 35370A-7 strip



Piece together two additional Panel A pieces. You should have 3 total. Set aside.

### STEP 3: MAKE PANEL B

Using 2 of the 35362A-7 2" x WOF strips, sew one short end together, making a 2" x 86" strip. Repeat with 2 more strips to make one additional 86" long strip. You'll have 2 total.

Repeat with the following pieces to make (2) 86" long strips of each color: 35370A-2 2" x WOF strips 35509-2 1 1/2" x WOF strips


Repeat, using the 35509-1 2 1/2" x WOF strips to make (1) 86" long strip.

To make the triangle strips we'll use Half Square Triangles (HST).

Stack one 35370A-2 2 1/4" square and one 33509-5 2 1/4" square. Draw one diagnal line from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" on either side of this line. Cut the piece in half on the drawn line. Open your piece, press, and trim to a 1 3/4" square. Repeat this process to make 144 HST blocks. Piece together the ends of 72 squares to make one strip. Repeat with the remaining 72 HST blocks to make a second strip.

Piece Panel in the following order:

HST Strip 2" 35362A-7 Strip 2" 35370A-2 Strip 1 1/2" 35509-2 Strip 2 1/2" 35509-1 Strip 1 1/2" 35509-2 Strip 2" 35370A-2 Strip 2" 35362A-7 Strip HST Strip



Set Aside.

### STEP 4: MAKE PANEL C

Using 2 of the 35362A-7 2" x WOF strips, sew one short end together, making a 2" x 86" strip. Repeat with 2 more strips to make one additional 86" long strips. You'll have two total.

Repeat with 35370A-2 1 1/2" x WOF strips to make (2) 86" long strips.

Repeat with the 35502-X 4 1/2"x WOF strips to make (1) 86" long strip.

To make the triangle strips we'll use Half Square Triangles (HST).

Stack one 35370A-2 2 1/4" square and one 35509-2 2 1/4" square. Draw one diagnal line from corner to corner. Stitch 1/4" on either side of this line. Cut the piece in half on the drawn line. Open your piece, press, and trim to a 1 3/4" square. Repeat this process to make 144 HST blocks. Piece together the ends of 72 squares to make one strip. Repeat with the remaining 72 HST blocks to make a second strip.

Piece Panel in the following order:

HST Strip 2" 35362A-7 Strip 1 1/2" 35370A-2 Strip 4 1/2" 35502-X Strip 1 1/2" 35370A-2 Strip 2" 35362A-7 Strip HST Strip




#### STEP 5: MAKE BACKGROUND STRIPS

To piece together 35362A-7 background strips we'll sew the selvedge ends together to make 86" strips. Use the reamaining 35362-A strips to make the following:

(4) 4" x 86" Strips (2) 2 1/4" x 86" Strips

### STEP 6: ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP

Use the diagram below to assemble your quilt top using the white background strips and your 5 Panels:



(\*Flip this panel so chevron is facing the opposite direction.)

### STEP 7: FINISH UP

Square up side edges, trimming off the selvedges. Quilt and bind as desired.
