Fabric Requirements:

Windham Blendables

1/2 yard: cabernet, navy, sage, brown

1-1/2 yards: black

4 yards: natural (backing)

3/4 yard: black (binding)

Quilt Instructions:

Before beginning cut:

Border 1 A: (2) 2-1/2” x 54-1/2” natural

Border 1 B: (2) 2-1/2” x 58-1/2” natural

Star Block:

For each block cut:

Natural: A: (4) 2-1/2” squares

B: (1) 4-1/4” square, cut on both diagonals to form (4) quarter square triangles

Dark:

Star Points: C: (4) 2-3/8” blocks, cut once on the diagonal to form half-square triangles

Star Center: D: (2) 2” squares of one color fabric

E: (2) 2” squares of another color fabric

Star Block Assembly:

Four Patch Unit:



Sew a D to an E. Repeat. Sew the two strips together as shown.
Block measures 3-1/2”, unfinished.

Star Points Unit:



Sew C to a short side of a B triangle. Press. Repeat on opposite side.
Section measures 2” x 3-1/2”, unfinished. Make (4) sections.

Block Assembly:



Sew an A to one side of the star point unit. Repeat on opposite side.

This section now measures 2” x 6-1/2”, unfinished. Make (2).

Sew a star point unit to one side of the four patch unit.

Repeat on opposite side. Press.

This section measures 3-1/2” x 6-1/2”, unfinished.

Assemble the three sections as shown in photo.

Block measures 6-1/2” x 6-1/2”, unfinished.

Make (49) blocks.

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Quilt Center Assembly:

Cut: F: (36) 2-1/2” squares black
G: (84) 2-1/2” x 6-1/2” neutral

Assemble in rows.

Row 1: block, G, block, G, block, G, block, G, block, G, block, G, block

Row 2: G, F, G, F, G, F, G, F, G, F, G, F, G

Continue assembling quilt center by alternating these rows. Use quilt photo as a guide.

Border 1:

Attach Border 1 A to right side of quilt. Repeat on left side. Press.
Attach Border 1 B to top of quilt. Repeat on bottom. Press.

Border 2:

Cut A: (58) 2-7/8” squares black
B: (58) 2-7/8” squares neutral
C: (4) 2-1/2” squares neutral

Half Square Triangle Unit:

Draw a diagonal line on a B. Match up with an A and sew 1/4” from each side of the line. Cut on the line to form (2) half square triangle units measuring 2-1/2”, unfinished. Make 116.



Sew (29) Half-Square Triangle units together in a row. Attach to left side of quilt. Repeat for right side. Press.
Sew (29) Half-Square Triangle units together. Sew a C to each end of the row. Attach this row to the top of the quilt. Repeat for bottom. Press.

Layer, quilt and bind.
