Backing Fabric: 4 YD (42" wide)

Batting: 70" X 70"

T = Tall W = Wide

General Instructions:

- All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.

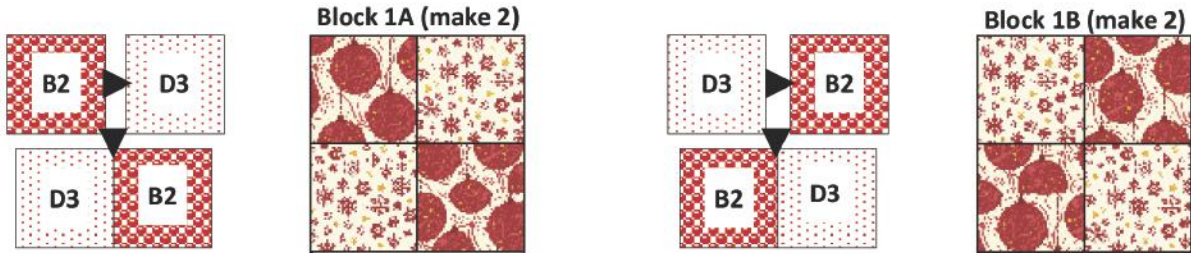


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Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block diagrams and images for proper placement and rotation)

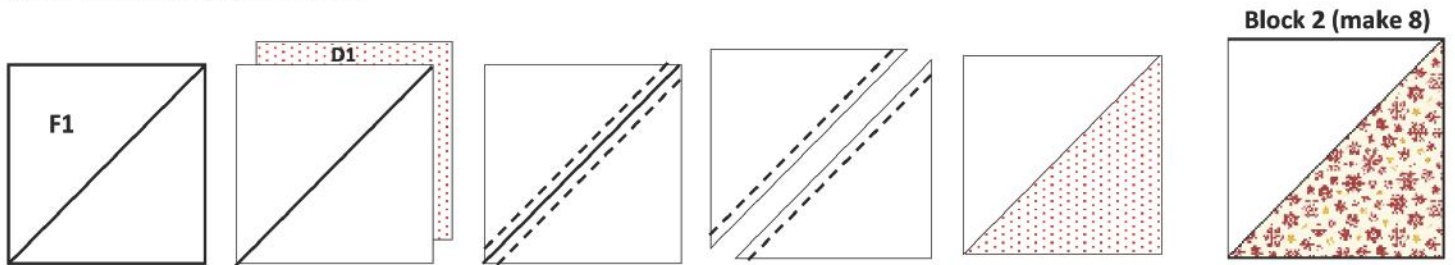
Block 1A and 1B (make 2 each, square to 10-1/2")

1. Sew (2) B2 squares and (2) D3 squares together as shown to create **Block 1A**.
2. Sew (2) B2 squares and (2) D3 squares together as shown to create **Block 1B**.



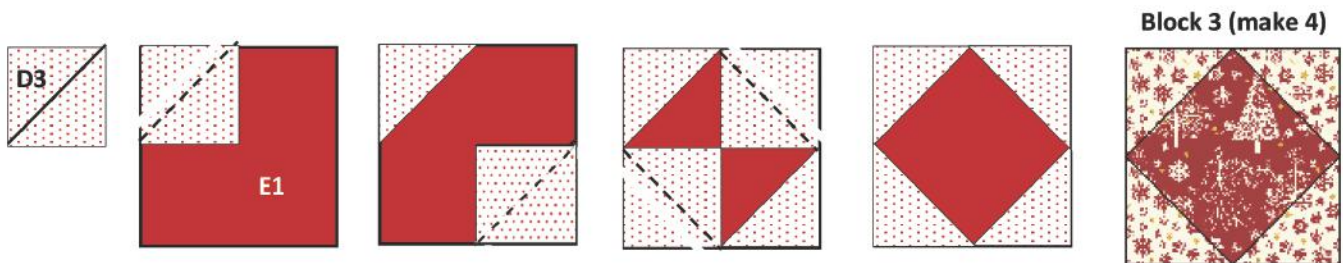
Block 2 (make 8, square to 10-1/2")

3. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F1 square. Place F1 square right sides together with (1) D1 square. Sew 1/4" on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open. Square to 10-1/2", repeat 3 more times to create (8) **Block 2s**.



Block 3 (make 4, square to 10-1/2")

4. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (16) D3 squares. Place (1) D3 square right sides together in top left corner of (1) E1 square, then sew on diagonal line. Trim excess fabric on the reverse side to 1/4". Press D corner open towards the E corner. Repeat on remaining 3 corners of E square to complete **Block 3**.

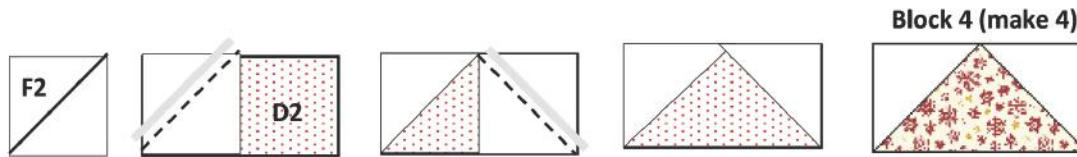




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Block 4 (make 4, square to 5-1/2" X 10-1/2")

5. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) F2 squares. Place (1) F2 square right sides together on left side of (1) D2 rectangle, then sew on diagonal line. Trim excess fabric on the reverse side to 1/4". Press F corner open towards the D corner. Repeat on other side of D rectangle to complete **Block 4**.



Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation)

Quilt Assembly:

6. Sew pieces and blocks together into sections (seams indicated by blue arrows first, then seams indicated by green arrows). Sew sections into horizontal rows (orange arrows), then sew rows together (black arrows) to complete quilt center.

Border Assembly:

Border 1:

7. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 50-1/2"), cut (2) F 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 52-1/2") cut (2) F 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 2:

8. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 52-1/2"), cut (2) E 5-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.
9. Sew the 5-1/2" X 62-1/2" E length of fabric strips to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
