All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY / BLOCK ONE:

1. Sew (1) B1 to right side of (1) D1 and press, then sew (1) B2 to bottom and press.
2. Sew (1) $\mathbf{G} 1$ to left side and press, then sew (1) $\mathbf{G} 2$ to top and press.
3. Sew (1) B3 to right side and press, then sew (1) B4 to bottom and press.
4. Sew (1) H1 to left side and press, then sew (1) $\mathbf{H} \mathbf{2}$ to top and press.
5. Sew (1) E1 to right side and press, then sew (1) E2 to bottom and press.

Square block to 12-1/2". Make 4 Block Ones, refer to Quilt Diagram for proper orientation of $\boldsymbol{B}$ and $\boldsymbol{H}$ fabrics.

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## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

## BLOCKS TWO AND THREE:

6. Similar to Block One assembly, sew B, E, G and H pieces around D 3-1/2" $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle as shown in block diagrams. Refer to the charts for pieces and Quilt Diagram for proper orientation of $\mathbf{H}$ fabric pieces. Make (2) of each.

QUILT ASSEMBLY Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation
7. Sew (1) BLOCK 3A to (1) BLOCK 3B, then sew to right side of $\mathbf{A}$ Panel.
8. Sew (1) BLOCK 3A to (1) BLOCK 3B, then sew to left side of $\mathbf{A}$ Panel.
9. Sew together (2) BLOCK Is, (1) BLOCK 2A and (1) BLOCK 2B, then sew to top of quilt.
10. Sew together (2) BLOCK Is, (1) BLOCK 2A and (1) BLOCK 2B, then sew to bottom of quilt.

## BORDER ASSEMBLY

11. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) H 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 61-1/2") cut (2) H 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

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## BORDER ASSEMBLY continued

12. Measure sides of quilt (ours is $64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ), cut (2) F $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is $67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) cut (2) $\mathbf{F} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.
