## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. FLYING GEESE UNITS: Place (1) F $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the left side of (1) $\mathbf{D} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Repeat for right side as shown.
Make (12) D/F Flying Geese units. Set aside.


Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal F corner triangle. Repeat on opposite corner.

Make (12) D2/F2 units
2. Similar to step 1 flying geese unit assembly, make (16) CE units, using C $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and E 3-1/2" squares.


Make (16) C/E units

3. INNER SIDE STRIPS: Sew (3) D/F units together, end to end to make side strips.

Note proper rotation of units. Make (4) D/F side strips.

4. Sew (1) D $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to each end of (1) D/F side strip unit. Make (2) D-D/F side strips. Forest Version

5. OUTER SIDE STRIPS: Similar to D/F inner side strip units, make (4) C/E outer side strips.

6. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" square to each end of (1) C/E outer side strip unit. Make (2) E-C/E side strips.

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## BORDER | QUILT ASSEMBLY

7. CENTER BLOCK: Sew D/F and D-D/F inner side strip units to sides and top/bottom of $\mathbf{A} 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ "square to make Center Block. Refer to quilt diagram. Note proper rotation of inner side strips.
8. Sew (1) B $3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 16-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 3-3/4" $\times 23^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) F $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) F 1-1/4" $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew $\mathbf{C / E}$ and $\mathbf{E - C / E}$ outer side strip units to sides and top / bottom of the quilt center, as shown in quilt diagram. Note proper rotation of outer side strips.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using F 2-1/4" strips.
