Additional Requirements:

17" x 13" rectangle of white light weight woven fusible for pillow face lining
 (1) 12" x 16" oblong pillow form insert

Special Notes:

*** All seam allowances are 1/4" wide
 Make sure you take your time to cut and sew carefully.
 The pillow cover will be 12" x 16" finished*

Cutting Instructions:

50828P-X Multi

Cut (1) 13 3/4" x 10 1/2" each block from panel for pillow face

From 50087-32 Amazonia

Cut (2) each 10 1/2" x 1 7/8" strips for pillow face sides

Cut (2) each 16 1/2" x 1 5/8" strips for pillow face top and bottom

Cut (1) each 12 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle for the top side of pillow back

Cut (1) each 12 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangle for the underside of the pillow back

Light Weight Woven Fusible Interlining

Cut (1) 12" x 16" rectangle

Assembly:

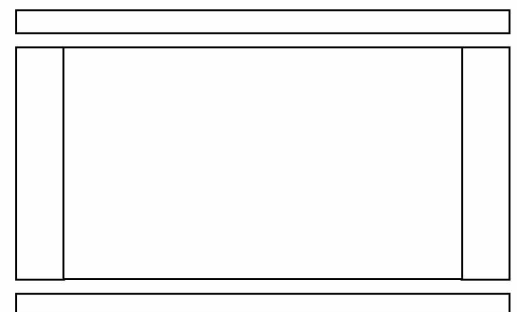
Pillow Face:

1. With right sides together, sew a side strip on each side of the puppy panel. Press seams open. Diagram 1
2. Take one strip for the top and sew it to puppy panel Repeat for the bottom strip. Press seams open. Diagram 2

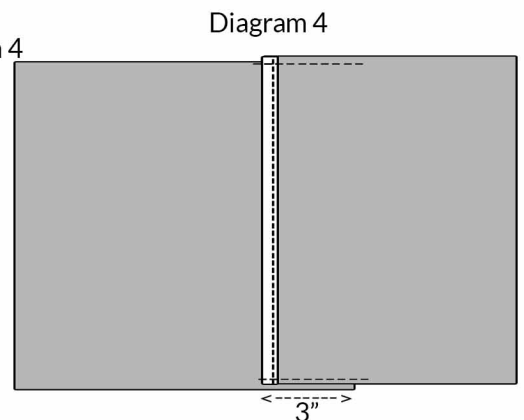
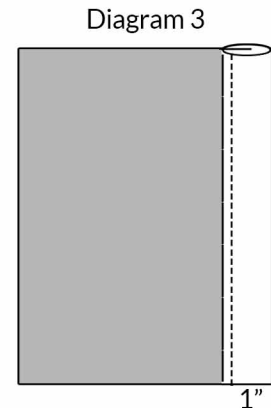
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3. With wrong sides together, place the fusible interlining on to the puppy pillow face. Following the manufacturer's recommended instructions, adhere the fusible to the pillow face. Trim to fit the pillow face if necessary. This will keep the inside of the pillow nice and clean. Set aside.

Pillow Back

4. Take 12 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle of the backing and on one short end, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge. Diagram 3
5. Take 12 1/2" x 11 1/2" rectangle and on one short end, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1/4" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge.
6. With right sides facing down, overlap so that the piece with the narrow hem is on top. The final measurement should be 16". Pin the sides together to hold in place. The overlap is approximately 3". Diagram 4
7. Add an edge stitch on each end to hold the overlapped sections in place. Diagram 4



Finishing:

8. With right sides together, place face on back and sew around the outside of the pillow shell on all 4 sides. Clip corner seam allowance and cover stitch seam allowance edges or add a tight zigzag stitch to prevent raveling. Turn and press.
9. Insert pillow form to complete your pillow.

Feel free to change the puppy panel to the puppy of your choice from the 6 different images on the panel.
