Additional Requirements:

1 1/4 yards white light weight woven fusible for pillow face lining
 (4) 19" x 13" oblong pillow form for inserts

Special Notes:

*** All seam allowances are 1/4" wide
 Make sure you take your time to cut and sew carefully.*

Cutting Instructions:

50828P-X Multi

Cut (1) 17 1/2" x 12" each block from panel for pillow face

From Bedrock each print pattern

Cut (2) each 12" x 1 1/2" strips for pillow face sides

Cut (2) each 19 1/2" x 1 1/4" strips for pillow face top and bottom

Cut (1) each 13 1/2" x 12" rectangle for the top side of pillow back

Cut (1) each 13 1/2" x 12 1/4" rectangle for the underside of the pillow back

Light Weight Woven Fusible Interlining

Cut (4) 19 1/2" x 13 1/2" rectangle

Assembly:

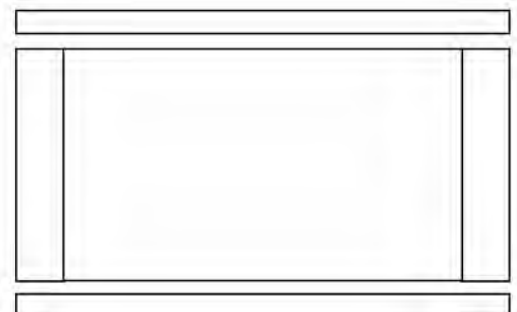
Pillow Face:

1. Take one pillow face and sew a side strip on each side of face. Press seams open. Diagram 1
2. Take one strip for the top and sew it to pillow face. Repeat for the bottom strip. Press seams open. Diagram 2

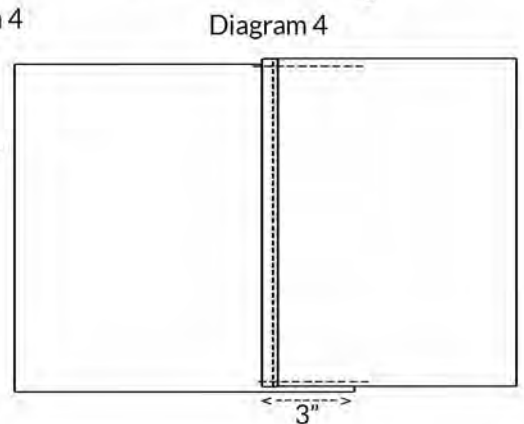
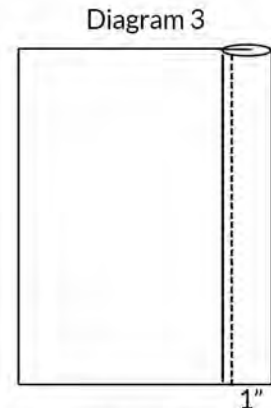


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3. With wrong sides together, place the fusible interlining on to the pillow. Following the manufacturer's recommended instructions, adhere the fusible to the pillow face. This will keep the inside of the pillow nice and clean. Set aside.

Pillow Back:

4. Take 13 1/2" x 12" rectangle of the backing and on one short end, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge. Diagram 3
5. Take 13 1/2" x 12 1/4" rectangle and on one short end, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1/4" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge.
6. With right sides facing down, overlap so that the piece with the narrow hem is on top. The final measurement should be 19 1/2". Pin the sides together to hold in place. The overlap is approximately 3". Diagram 4
7. Add an edge stitch on each end to hold the overlapped sections in place. Diagram 4



Finishing:

8. With right sides together, place face on back and sew around the outside of the pillow shell on all 4 sides. Clip corner seam allowance and cover stitch seam allowance edges or add a tight zigzag stitch to prevent raveling. Turn and press.
9. Add a pillow form to complete your pillow.
10. Repeat for the other 3 pillows
