В		3500-X Honey	1-2/3	 (4) 2-3/4" x WOF strips; subcut (48) 2-3/4" squares. Subcut diagonally once to make 96 Triangles. (96) Triangle Template 1. FOR BINDING: (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips; sew ends together.
С		3501-X Ocean	1/3	(1) 6-7/8" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 6-7/8" squares.
D		3502-X Ocean	3/4	 (1) 6-7/8" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 6-7/8" squares. (6) 2" x WOF strips; sew ends of strips together. Subcut (2) 2" x 64" and (2) 2" x 50-1/2" borders. (1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut (20) 2" squares.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (48) A 2-3/8" squares. Make 48.




- Make 48
- **2.** Place (1) **A** 2-3/8" square on upper right corner of (1) **C** 6-7/8" square. Sew along the drawn line. Trim seam allowance 1/4" from the drawn line as indicated by the solid line.
- **3.** Press the **A** piece open.
- **4.** Following steps 2-3, sew (1) **A** 2-3/8" square to the remaining 3 corners of the **C** 6-7/8" square to complete (1) **A/C** center unit. Make 1.

- 5. Sew (1) B Triangle Template 1 to (1) A Triangle Template 2 to make an A/B triangle unit.
- **6.** Sew (1) **B** Triangle Template 1 to (1) **F** Triangle Template 2 to make a **B/F** triangle unit.
- **7.** Sew together (1) **A/B** triangle unit and (1) **B/F** triangle unit matching seams to make a small petal unit. Make 4.





- **8.** Sew (1) **F** Template 3 and (1) **F** Template 3 reversed to sides of the small petal unit.
- 9. Sew (1) B 2-3/4" triangle to the diagonal edge of the F Template 3 and F template 3 reversed to make a short petal unit. Make 4.
- **10.** Sew (2) **F** 2-3/4" triangle to ends of (2) of the short petal units to make long petal units. Make 2.



- 11. Sew (2) short petal units to sides of (1) A/C center unit.
- **12.** Sew (2) long petal units to top and bottom to make the sunflower.
- 13. Sew (4) H 4-5/8" triangles to diagonal edges of the sunflower to make a square. Blocks should measure 12-1/2" square including seam allowance. Make 3.
- **14.** Similar to Block 1 assembly, make (3) Block 4 with **H** 6-7/8" square for center of block.






15. Cut (6) G 4-5/8" triangles in each direction as shown.

Note fabric orientation when cutting, print is directional.

16. Similar to Block 1 assembly, make (3) of each Block 2 and Block 3 using **D** and **E** 6-7/8" squares for center of block and G 4-5/8 triangles for corners. Note orientation of G triangles.





- **17.** Following the layout diagram on page 5, arrange the blocks in (4) rows of (3) blocks each. Sew together (4) I 2" x 12-1/2" strips alternating with the (3) blocks to make the block rows. Make 4.
- **18.** Sew together (4) **D** 2" squares alternating with (3) **I** 2" x 12-1/2" strips to make the sashing rows. Make 5.
- 19. Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows to make the quilt center.

BORDERS


- **20.** Sew (1) **H** 4-1/2" x 56" border to each side of the quilt center. Sew (2) **H** 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" borders to top and bottom of the quilt.
- **21.** Sew (1) **D** 2" x 64" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **I** 2" squares to ends of (2) **D** 2" x 50-1/2" borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.





QUILT LAYOUT

Sunflowers



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **B** 2-1/4" strips.
